

Incentive program for Clubs and Affinity Groups to support Alumni Career Fair 2010

In order to drive employer participation in the annual Alumni Career Fair, an incentive program was developed to encourage active marketing to Alumni Association volunteers within Alumni Clubs and Affinity Groups. The Club or Affinity Group responsible for the most Career Fair employer registrants to the 2010 Fair will receive \$500 for their organization's scholarship fund.

Qualifications – Any recognized GTAA Alumni Club, Affinity Group, or official Georgia Tech Student Organization with an existing scholarship. Every official entry must reference a group member's name (referring alumnus/a) in the Career Fair registration form.

Timing – Begins on February 1, 2010, Ends on March 22, 2010. All Career Fair employer registration referrals will be considered.

Other details – If an Alumni Club or Affinity Group does not have an active scholarship in place but participates and wins the competition, the money will be awarded to the following: a qualifying, chartered student group's associated scholarship or the Georgia Tech Promise program in the name of the group. In the case of a tie, the groups will share the scholarship amount divided equally.
